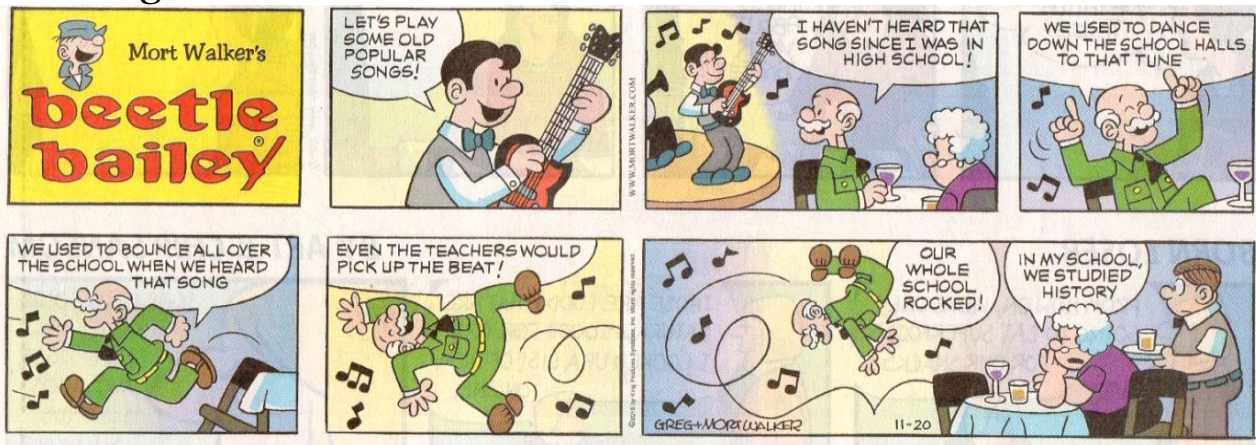

Elementary School:

Any Group Pictures that represent the enrollment (i.e. First Grade Classroom Picture or Any Group Picture of a Student Production). If you know a friend who is sending them, it is not necessary for you to send them as well. Only two pictures will be utilized to represent each elementary school.

Junior High School:

Activity Pictures: (i.e. Football Team, Basketball Team, Cheerleaders, Band, Student Council, and Newspaper/Yearbook Staff. Add to those, three (3) pictures of dances involving students). Again, I only need one set of these pictures from each Jr. High. You can copy some or all of them from your 9th Grade Yearbook, if you have one.

High School:

Senior Year Graduation Picture: Most of the HHS' Graduates are shown in my 1962 annual. However, a copy of the original will produce a higher quality picture. If you are a “Friend” of the Class of ‘62, please send a copy of your senior picture and the name of the high school you attended.

- 2.) Your most recent picture, 2016 or 2017

The second slide will include:

- 1.) A written resume through the years in 80-100 words

The third slide will include:

- 1.) A picture of you as a “toddler” with a humorous caption (8 to 10 words)
- 2.) A picture of you at elementary age: (5 to 10 years old) with a humorous caption (8-10 words)

The fourth slide will include:

- 1.) A picture of you in your early teens with a humorous caption (8-10 words)
- 2.) A picture of you in your later teens with a humorous caption (8-10 words)

The fifth slide will include:

- 1.) A picture of you as a middle aged adult with a humorous caption (8 -10 words)
- 2.) A picture of you near retirement age with a humorous caption (8-10 words)

(If you are unable to locate a picture in particular age group, please substitute another age group.) Ideally, I would like to receive eight (8) pictures from as many “classmates” or “friends of the class” as possible. Please send your pictures to me ASAP because the process is long and complicated and I need as much lead time as possible. This should be fun...
